A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to deregulation of public utilities furnishing collection and disposal service
2 of waste material."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 38.05.810(f) is amended to read:

5 (f) The commissioner shall lease state land for telephone or electric transmission and
6 distribution lines for less than the appraised value of the land if the lessee is a nonprofit
7 cooperative association organized under AS 10.25. The commissioner may lease state land that
8 is not located within the boundary of a municipality for the disposal of garbage, refuse, trash, or
9 other waste material for less than the appraised value of the land if the lessee is approved by
10 the commissioner and collects and disposes [A LICENSED PUBLIC UTILITY AUTHORIZED
11 TO COLLECT AND DISPOSE] of garbage, refuse, trash, or other waste material outside the
12 boundaries of a municipality. Before determining the annual rental, the commissioner shall
13 consider the nature of the public service rendered by the nonprofit cooperative association or
14 approved lessee [LICENSED PUBLIC UTILITY] and the terms of the grant under which the

1 land was acquired by the state. A nonprofit cooperative association may not construct improve-
2 ments other than transmission or distribution lines and substations on land leased under this
3 subsection. An approved lessee [A LICENSED PUBLIC UTILITY] may not construct perma-
4 nent improvements on land leased under this subsection that are not related to the purpose of the
5 lease.

6 * Sec. 2. AS 29.35.050(b), 29.35.050(d), AS 42.05.711(i), 42.05.711(m), and 42.05.720(4)(F) are
7 repealed.
