A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to eligibility for a permanent fund dividend; and providing for an
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 43.23.095(8) is amended to read:

5 (8) "state resident" means an individual who is physically present in the state with
6 the intent to remain permanently in the state or, if the individual is not physically present in the
7 state, intends to return to the state and is absent only for any of the following reasons:

8 (A) vocational, professional, or other specific education for which a
9 comparable program was not reasonably available in the state;

10 (B) secondary or postsecondary education;

11 (C) military service;

12 (D) medical treatment;

13 (E) service in Congress;

14 (F) other reasons which the commissioner may establish by regulation;

(G) service in the Peace Corps; or

(H) to alleviate a medical condition if the individual is at least 65 years of age and is absent at the direction of a physician;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1992.
