A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to hunting for mountain goat by nonresident hunters; and providing for
2 an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue, or take brown bear, grizzly bear,
6 [MOUNTAIN GOAT,] or sheep in this state, unless personally accompanied by

7 (1) a person who is licensed as a guide-outfitter, class-A assistant guide-outfitter,
8 or assistant guide-outfitter by the Big Game Commercial Services Board; or

9 (2) a resident over 19 years of age who is

10 (A) the spouse of the nonresident; or

11 (B) related to the nonresident, within and including the second degree of
12 kindred, by marriage or blood.

13 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1992.
