A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act repealing the moratorium on the use of broadcasting to promote or conduct
2 charitable gaming activity; expressing the intent of the legislature that the state policy
3 toward the use of broadcasting to promote or conduct charitable gaming activity should
4 be consistent with federal law; and providing for an effective date."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

6 * **Section 1.** INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature that the policy of the state toward the use
7 of broadcasting to promote or conduct charitable gaming should be consistent with federal law as
8 expressed in 18 U.S.C. 1304 and 1307, and that the state should not impose restrictions beyond those
9 imposed by federal law.

10 * **Sec. 2.** Chapter 33, SLA 1990, is repealed.

11 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the use of broadcasting to promote charitable gaming activity;
2 prohibiting that use to conduct charitable gaming activity and to promote charitable gaming
3 activity involving pull-tabs; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature that the policy of the state toward the use
6 of broadcasting to promote charitable gaming should be generally consistent with federal law as
7 expressed in 18 U.S.C. 1304 and 1307.

8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 05.15.180 is amending by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (h) A person may not use broadcasting to conduct charitable gaming activity under this
10 chapter or to promote charitable gaming activity under this chapter that involves pull-tabs. In
11 this subsection, "broadcasting" includes television and radio transmission by 2,500 megahertz,
12 microwave video and audio programming, slow-scan television programming, and programming
13 via satellite, cable, teletype, or facsimile transmission and distribution methods.

14 * **Sec. 3.** Section 1, ch. 33, SLA 1990 is repealed.

1 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
