**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to regulations of the Board of Fisheries and Board of Game applicable**  
2 **to units of the national park system."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 16.05.251 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (g) The Board of Fisheries may not adopt a regulation applicable within a unit of the  
6 national park system that is more restrictive than a corresponding regulation of the National Park  
7 Service applicable within the unit, unless the board

8 (1) makes a finding that the more restrictive regulation is necessary for  
9 conservation of fisheries within each affected unit of the national park system; and

10 (2) adopts the regulation by two-thirds affirmative vote of the membership of the  
11 board.

12 **\* Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.255 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

13 (e) The Board of Game may not adopt a regulation applicable within a unit of the  
14 national park system that is more restrictive than a corresponding regulation of the National Park

1 Service applicable within the unit, unless the board  
2 (1) makes a finding that the more restrictive regulation is necessary for  
3 conservation of game within each affected unit of the national park system; and  
4 (2) adopts the regulation by two-thirds affirmative vote of the membership of the  
5 board.
