**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to a temporary grant program for certain individuals who served in  
 2 active duty in the Persian Gulf or as a result of the Persian Gulf War; and providing  
 3 for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* **Section 1. GRANTS FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO SERVED IN THE MILITARY. (a)**  
 6 The Department of Revenue shall pay a grant of \$500 to a state resident, or the resident's estate, if the  
 7 resident

8 (1) as a member of the military forces of the United States, served in active duty in the  
 9 Persian Gulf at any time during September 1, 1990, through March 15, 1991, or as a member of a United  
 10 States military reserve, the United States Coast Guard reserve, or the Alaska National Guard served in  
 11 active duty outside of the United States at any time during September 1, 1990, through March 15, 1991,  
 12 as a result of the Persian Gulf War; and

13 (2) is qualified to receive a permanent fund dividend for 1991 or the resident's estate is  
 14 qualified to receive the dividend.

1 (b) A grant may not be paid except upon written application for the grant on a form prepared  
2 by the department. The claimant must file the application with the department no later than  
3 December 31, 1991. The department shall require proof of the right to the grant.

4 (c) The Department of Revenue shall pay grants under (a) of this section from appropriations  
5 for the purpose. If appropriations are not sufficient to fully fund all grants, the amount available shall  
6 be distributed pro rata among eligible individuals.

7 \* Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act is repealed March 1, 1992.
