**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

**1 "An Act relating to state aid for school health clinics."**

**2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**3 \* Section 1.** AS 14.17.031(a) is amended to read:

**4 (a)** The department shall adopt regulations defining funding communities within each  
**5** district which reflect geographic and attendance area factors. For the purpose of determining  
**6** instructional units, students are counted in the district and the funding community from which  
**7** they receive educational services. The total number of instructional units in a school district is  
**8** the sum of the following units for each funding community within the district, as determined by  
**9** the department

**10 (1)** the number of units for elementary and secondary students determined under  
**11** AS 14.17.041(a) or (b);

**12 (2)** the number of units for vocational education determined under AS 14.17.043;

**13 (3)** the number of units for special education determined under AS 14.17.045;

**14 [AND]**

1 (4) the number of units for bilingual education determined under AS 14.17.047;

2 **and**

3 **(5) the number of units for health clinics determined under AS 14.17.049.**

4 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 14.17.049. HEALTH CLINIC INSTRUCTIONAL UNITS. A funding community  
6 that operates a health clinic approved by the department shall receive instructional units  
7 determined under the following table:

9 1 - 10	1
10 11 - 50	2
11 51 - 100	2.5
12 101 - 500	3
13 501 or greater	4
