A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to correctional industries."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 33.32.080(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) The Correctional Industries Commission shall hold public hearings to provide an
5 opportunity for persons or organizations who may be affected by the plans of the correctional
6 industries program to appear and present testimony concerning those plans. The Correctional
7 Industries Commission shall hold a hearing under this section when the correctional
8 industries program proposes either entering into a new area of industry or expanding the
9 scope of an existing area of industry beyond the scope considered at a previous hearing.

10 The Correctional Industries Commission shall adopt rules governing the conduct of those
11 hearings, including provisions to assure that adequate public notice of the hearing is given before
12 the hearing. The Correctional Industries Commission may also hold public hearings under these
13 rules on any matter within its jurisdiction. Rules adopted under this subsection are not subject
14 to the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).
