A BILL
FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act authorizing moose and caribou farming."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 16.40.010 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 16.40.010. DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS BUFFALO, MOOSE, CARIBOU, OR
5 [AND] MUSK OXEN. Whenever it is determined by the department that a surplus [EXISTS IN
6 THE HERDS] of buffalo, moose, caribou, or [AND] musk oxen exists [UNDER ITS
7 CONTROL], the department may, under regulations adopted by it, grant the surplus or portions
8 of it to persons, groups, associations, partnerships, or corporations for the purpose of raising and
9 breeding the animals as domestic stock for commercial purposes, or for scientific and educational
10 purposes. A person, group, association, partnership, or corporation may receive animals only
11 after proving to the satisfaction of the department

12 (1) intent to raise and breed the animals; and

13 (2) possession of facilities for maintaining the animals under positive control.

14 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.40.020 is amended to read:

1 Sec. 16.40.020. SALE OF MEAT. The sale of buffalo, moose, caribou, or musk oxen
2 meat resulting from the slaughter of animals obtained under AS 16.40.010, or their offspring is
3 authorized.
