A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the maximum length of salmon seine vessels; and providing for an
2 effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 16.05.835 is amended to read:

5 Sec. 16.05.835. MAXIMUM LENGTH OF SALMON SEINE VESSELS. A salmon
6 seine vessel may not be longer than 58 feet overall length except vessels that have fished for
7 salmon with seines in waters of the state before January 1, 1962, as 50-foot, official Coast Guard
8 register length vessels. In this section, "overall length" means the straight line length between
9 the extremities of the vessel excluding stern rollers used exclusively to deploy and retrieve
10 salmon seine net fishing gear and anchor rollers.

11 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
