A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to compensation of legislators; and providing for an effective date."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 24.10.100 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 24.10.100. SALARY OF LEGISLATORS. The annual [MONTHLY] salary for
5 each member of the legislature is equal to step A, Range 16 [RANGE 10] of the salary schedule
6 in AS 39.27.011(a) for Juneau. The president of the senate and the speaker of the house of
7 representatives are each entitled to an additional \$500 a year during tenure of office.

8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 24.10.105(c) is amended to read:

9 (c) A legislator is entitled to receive per diem at the long-term rate
10 [(1)] during a legislative session if the legislator is living in the legislator's place
11 of permanent residence during the session [; AND
12 (2) WHILE ENGAGED IN COMMITTEE BUSINESS OR OTHER
13 LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS AT THE LEGISLATOR'S PLACE OF PERMANENT
14 RESIDENCE].

1 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1991.
