A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act repealing the limitation on the hours a person may be employed in a mine and
2 making a related technical amendment to the penalties established for failing to make
3 payments into an employee benefit fund; and providing for an effective date."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5 * Section 1. AS 23.10.045(b) is amended to read:

6 (b) Each violation of this section is a separate offense and a person found guilty of a
7 violation is punishable under (c) - (d) of this section [IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
8 SCHEDULE OF PUNISHMENT SET OUT IN AS 23.10.415].

9 * Sec. 2. AS 23.10.045 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (c) A person who, whether as principal or agent, violates this section is guilty of a
11 misdemeanor and upon a first conviction is punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more
12 than \$500 or by imprisonment in a jail for not less than 60 days, nor more than six months, or
13 by both.

14 (d) Upon a second conviction for a violation of this section, the punishment is

1 imprisonment in a jail for not less than 60 days, nor more than one year. A "second conviction"
2 under this section means a conviction for a violation of this section that was committed within
3 two years after a previous conviction for a violation of this section. Other convictions are first
4 convictions.

5 * Sec. 3. AS 23.10.405, 23.10.410, and 23.10.415 are repealed.

6 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
