A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending the time limitation for prosecution for certain offenses committed
2 against a minor."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 12.10.020(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) Even if the general time limitation has expired, a prosecution under AS 11.41.410 -
6 11.41.460, AS 11.66.110 - 11.66.130, former AS 11.41.430, or former AS 11.51.130(a)(4), for
7 an offense committed against a person under the age of 16 may be commenced within one year
8 after the crime is reported to a peace officer or the person reaches the age of 16, whichever
9 occurs first. This subsection does not extend the period of limitation by more than seven [FIVE]
10 years.
