A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds in the amount of
2 \$170,000,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring, constructing, and equipping
3 public schools; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring, constructing, and equipping public
6 schools general obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than \$170,000,000 may
7 be issued and sold. The full faith, credit, and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the
8 principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds. These bonds shall be issued
9 under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

10 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, a special
11 fund of the state to be known as the "1992 school construction fund" shall be established to which shall
12 be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act except for the accrued
13 interest and premiums.

14 * Sec. 3. (a) The amount of \$170,000,000 is appropriated from the "1992 school construction fund"

1 to the Department of Education to be allocated in accordance with the following projects and estimates:

9 (b) The legislature may by law add additional school projects described under sec. 1 of this Act
10 or reallocate funds between projects described in (a) of this section.

11 * Sec. 4. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, the amount
12 of \$595,000 or as much of that amount as is found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of
13 the state to the state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay expenses incident
14 to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this Act. The amounts expended from the
15 appropriation authorized by this section shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the
16 sale of the bonds authorized by this Act.

17 * Sec. 5. The amount withdrawn from the public facility planning fund for the purpose of advance
18 planning for the improvements financed under this Act shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds
19 of the sale of bonds authorized by this Act.

20 * Sec. 6. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to be issued shall be submitted
21 to the qualified voters of the state at the next general election and shall read substantially as follows:

30 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
