**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

**1 "An Act relating to information concerning health benefits for retired members of certain  
2 retirement systems."**

**3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**4 \* Section 1. AS 14.25.168 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:**

**5 (e) The administrator shall inform members who have requested appointment to  
6 retirement that the health insurance coverage available to retired members may be different from  
7 the health insurance coverage provided to employees. The administrator shall also notify those  
8 members of time limits for selecting optional health insurance coverage and whether the election  
9 is irrevocable. A member who has requested appointment to retirement shall indicate in writing  
10 on a form provided by the administrator that the member has received the information required  
11 by this subsection and whether the member has chosen to receive optional health insurance  
12 coverage.**

**13 \* Sec. 2. AS 22.25.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:**

**14 (e) The administrator shall inform members who have requested appointment to**

20 The administrator shall also notify those members of time limits for selecting optional health insurance  
21 coverage and whether the election is irrevocable. A member who has requested appointment to  
22 retirement shall indicate in writing on a form provided by the administrator that the member has received  
23 the information required by this subsection and whether the member has chosen to receive optional  
24 health insurance coverage.
