A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to milk."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 \* Section 1. AS 03.05.020(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) In this section,

5 (1) "commissioner" means the commissioner of environmental conservation;

6 (2) "milk" includes milk that has not been pasteurized.

7 \* Sec. 2. AS 03.17.100 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

8 (5) "milk" includes milk that has not been pasteurized.

9 \* Sec. 3. AS 03.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 ARTICLE 2. SALE OF RAW MILK.

11 Sec. 03.17.200. SALE OF RAW MILK. (a) A person may sell goat or cow milk that  
12 has not been pasteurized. The sale shall comply with the conditions established by the  
13 commissioner of environmental conservation under AS 03.05.020(a), including the minimum  
14 standards established for grade A pasteurized milk.

1 (b) Notwithstanding AS 03.17.090, a person who violates (a) of this section is guilty of  
2 a class B misdemeanor.
