A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to repeal of
2 regulations by the legislature.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. Article II, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to
5 read:

6 SECTION 22. REPEAL OF REGULATIONS. The legislature may repeal a regulation
7 adopted by a state department or agency. The repeal of the regulation is effective thirty days
8 after the passage of a joint resolution by the legislature unless the joint resolution specifies a
9 different effective date.

10 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state
11 at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and
12 the election laws of the state.
