A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska requiring open primary
2 elections.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. Article V, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to
5 read:

6 SECTION 6. OPEN PRIMARY ELECTIONS. A qualified voter in a primary election
7 may vote for any candidate running in the primary election, subject to the legal requirements of
8 the number of votes that a voter may cast for one office.

9 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state
10 at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and
11 the general laws of the state.
