A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a Senate Special Committee on Oil and Gas.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

3 WHEREAS the state's dependence on oil revenue requires that the Alaska State Legislature be
4 well informed on all aspects related to the state's oil and gas resources;

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Oil and Gas is established
6 to study issues relating to oil and gas resources in the state; and be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the senate shall determine the number of senators
8 to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the
9 committee; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Special Committee on Oil and Gas may meet during
11 and between sessions of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature, and is terminated on the convening
12 of the First Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.
