**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Establishing a Senate Special Committee on Ethics Reform.**

**2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

**3 WHEREAS** the legislature and the public agree that the current legislative ethics law is in need  
**4 of reform; and**

**5 WHEREAS** the legislature should have a committee that has the time to examine proposed ethics  
**6 legislation in depth;**

**7 BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Ethics Reform is  
**8 established to study issues relating to the reform of the current legislative ethics law; and be it**

**9 FURTHER RESOLVED** that the president of the Senate shall determine the number of senators  
**10 to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the**  
**11 committee; and be it**

**12 FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Senate Special Committee on Ethics Reform may meet during  
**13 and between sessions of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature, and is terminated on the convening**  
**14 of the First Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.**
