A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a Senate Special Committee on International Trade and Tourism.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

3 WHEREAS international trade and tourism are of increasing importance to the economy of the
4 state; and

5 WHEREAS the legislature should be well-informed about developments in international trade
6 and tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and

7 WHEREAS the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for visitors to experience
8 Alaskan life and scenic grandeur; and

9 WHEREAS the state should promote and facilitate the export of the products and services of the
10 state;

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on International Trade and
12 Tourism is established to study issues relating to international trade and tourism; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the Senate shall determine the number of senators
14 to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the
15 committee; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Special Committee on International Trade and Tourism

1 may meet during and between sessions of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature, and is terminated
2 on the convening of the First Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.
