**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Establishing a Senate Special Committee on Family Law.**

**2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

**3 WHEREAS** public policy issues that involve matters of family law are some of the more  
**4 important issues** faced by the Alaska State Senate; and

**5 WHEREAS** the Alaska State Senate should be well informed about matters of family law in  
**6 order to fashion the best possible legislative responses** to current challenges facing Alaska families;

**7 BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Family Law  
**8 is established to study issues relating to family law in the state; and be it**

**9 FURTHER RESOLVED** that the president of the Senate shall determine the number of senators  
**10 to be members of the committee and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the**  
**11 committee; and be it**

**12 FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Senate Special Committee on Family Law may meet during  
**13 and between sessions of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on the convening**  
**14 of the First Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.**
