A RESOLUTION

1 Designating Alaska salmon as the official food of St. Valentine's Day.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

3 WHEREAS salmon is recognized all over the world for its beautiful red or pink color; and

4 WHEREAS Alaska salmon recently passed with flying colors a battery of tests establishing its
5 unparalleled purity; and

6 WHEREAS salmon's high protein content places it at the top of the list of foods that are
7 wholesome; and

8 WHEREAS Alaska salmon, of all the foods you can serve to your loved ones on a special day,
9 is one of the sweetest; and

10 WHEREAS salmon contains large amounts of naturally occurring anti-cholesterol agents, making
11 it good for your heart; and

12 WHEREAS Alaska salmon amaze humans with their annual upstream journeys, leaping even
13 high waterfalls in their heroic pursuit of love; and

14 WHEREAS the Senate considers there to be no better, more appropriate food than Alaska salmon
15 for consumption on St. Valentine's Day;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate designates Alaska salmon as the official food of St.

1 Valentine's Day; and be it

2 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Senate recommends that, on every February 14th,

3 (1) lovers everywhere in the world make it their custom to serve Alaska salmon at that
4 special meal;

5 (2) food programs financed in whole or in part with state money plan their menus so that
6 Alaska salmon is served;

7 (3) restaurants, grocery stores, and other appropriate businesses sponsor special
8 promotions involving Alaska salmon.
