**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Requesting full general delivery postal status for Butte, Alaska.**

**2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

**3 WHEREAS Butte, Alaska, has a population existing generally between the Knik River bridge  
4 and the Matanuska River bridge along the Glenn Highway; and**

**5 WHEREAS this is a hazardous area for maintenance of rural delivery private mail boxes,  
6 especially in winter when snow plowing necessitates frequent removal of snow from the boxes; and**

**7 WHEREAS there is no full service post office in Butte where post office boxes may be rented;  
8 and**

**9 WHEREAS there are no known outdoor, public, all-weather mail boxes for outgoing mail in the  
10 general area of Butte; and**

**11 WHEREAS Butte does not have its own zip code despite the special character of the community  
12 and the exemplary formal and volunteer services offered by postal workers to the residents of the  
13 community;**

**14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate respectfully requests the U.S. Postal Service to grant full  
15 general delivery postal status to Butte, Alaska, complete with a separate zip code, a new postmarking  
16 cancellation rubber stamp, and the opportunity to rent indoor general delivery post office boxes.**
