A RESOLUTION

1 Disapproving Executive Order No. 80.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
4 has proposed to transfer the functions of the Professional Teaching Practices Commission to the
5 Department of Education by Executive Order No. 80; and

6 WHEREAS the governor has submitted Executive Order No. 80 to the presiding officer of each
7 house of the legislature as required by AS 24.08.210; and

8 WHEREAS art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska provides that unless disapproved
9 within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of the members of the
10 legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date designated by the governor;
11 and

12 WHEREAS Executive Order No. 80 does not adequately reflect legislative policy;

13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 80 is disapproved.
