**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act limiting tenure in the legislature."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1. AS 24.05.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:**

4 (b) A person may not serve consecutively more than four full or partial terms  
5 as a representative. A person may not serve consecutively more than two full or  
6 partial terms as a senator. In addition, a person may not serve consecutively more than  
7 11 full or partial calendar years in the legislature.

8 **\* Sec. 2. APPLICATION. AS 24.05.030(b), added by sec. 1 of this Act, applies only to**  
9 **periods served in the legislature after 1992.**
