A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to state aid for education; and providing for an effective date."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 14.17.025(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) Local contributions to a city or borough school district shall include at least
5 the lesser of

6 (1) the equivalent of a four mill tax levy on the full and true value of
7 the taxable real and personal property in the district as of January 1, 1992, or as of
8 January 1 of the second preceding fiscal year, whichever tax is lower, as determined
9 by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs under AS 14.17.140 and
10 AS 29.45.110; or

11 (2) 35 percent of the district's basic need for the preceding fiscal year,
12 as determined under AS 14.17.021(b).

13 * **Sec. 2.** AS 14.17.041(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) For funding communities that are not included under (a) of this section,

1 (1) instructional units for elementary students are determined by the
2 formula: units = 15 + ((ADM-200)/16) [15 + ((ADM-200)/17)], where ADM is the
3 number of students in average daily membership in grades kindergarten through 6;

4 (2) instructional units for secondary students are determined by the
5 formula: units = 19 + ((ADM-200)/13) [18 + ((ADM-200)/13)], where ADM is the
6 number of students in average daily membership in grades 7 through 12.

7 * Sec. 3. AS 14.17.056 is amended to read:

8 Sec. 14.17.056. INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT VALUE. The instructional unit
9 value is \$61.500 [\$61,000].

10 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1993.
