A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act authorizing the Anchorage to Kenai Peninsula and the Healy to
2 Fairbanks power transmission interties and approving the design and construction
3 costs of the interties; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * Section 1. In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c) and contingent upon sec. 3 of this Act,
6 the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design and construct a 138 kilovolt power
7 transmission intertie between Anchorage and the Kenai Peninsula at a cost of \$103,500,000.
8 The transmission line shall be capable of being upgraded to 230 kilovolts.

9 * Sec. 2. In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c) and contingent upon sec. 3 of this Act, the
10 Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design and construct a 138 kilovolt power
11 transmission intertie between Healy and Fairbanks at a cost of \$76,500,000. The transmission
12 line shall be capable of being upgraded to 230 kilovolts.

13 * Sec. 3. The authorizations made by this Act are contingent upon written agreements
14 between the Alaska Energy Authority and participating electric utilities providing that the

- 1 participating utilities agree to pay
2 (1) 50 percent of the design and construction costs for the power transmission
3 interties authorized by this Act; and
4 (2) the operation and maintenance costs of the power transmission interties
5 authorized by this Act.
6 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
