A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the longevity bonus program; and providing for an effective
2 date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 47.45.010(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A person who is 65 years of age or over, who resides in the state for at
6 least one year immediately preceding application for a longevity bonus under this
7 chapter, may apply to the commissioner of administration for qualification to receive
8 a monthly bonus [OF \$250].

9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 47.45.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (e) The amount of a monthly longevity bonus equals

11 (1) \$250 during 1993;

12 (2) \$200 during 1994;

13 (3) \$150 during 1995;

14 (4) \$100 during 1996;
