A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to introduction of bills by the supreme court; and providing**
2 **for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1. AS 24.08.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:**

5 (c) The supreme court may recommend bills it considers necessary. A bill
6 may be delivered to the rules committee of either house with a letter signed by the
7 chief justice requesting introduction on behalf of the court. The bill shall be
8 introduced with the inscription "Rules Committee by Request of the Alaska Supreme
9 Court" and it shall be considered to carry the approval of the court as to policy and
10 effect on the budget. The court may submit a statement of purpose and effect with the
11 bill and appear through a representative before any committee considering the
12 legislation.

13 *** Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).**
