A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to grants awarded by the Alaska Science and Technology
2 Foundation."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 37.17.090(h) is amended to read:

5 (h) In awarding a grant under AS 37.17.010 - 37.17.110, the board of directors
6 shall give preference to an applicant who is an Alaska resident, association,
7 organization, university, or institution. If the board determines that an Alaskan
8 applicant does not have the expertise or capability to satisfactorily perform the grant
9 research without assistance from an out-of-state person or institution, the board may
10 award a grant, jointly, to the Alaskan applicant and an approved out-of-state person or
11 institution. If a grant is awarded to an out-of-state person or institution, the board may
12 require that the out-of-state grantee associate with an Alaska scientific or technical
13 organization while performing the grant research. In all cases, a grant may be awarded
14 only if the board determines that the research to be performed will further the purposes

1 of the foundation under AS 37.17.010(b).
