A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the organization of the Department of Transportation and  
2 Public Facilities into four regions."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 44.42.040 is amended to read:

5           Sec. 44.42.040. DEPARTMENTAL ORGANIZATION. The commissioner  
6 shall establish four regions within the state, southeast, central, northern, and rural.  
7 The rural region shall consist of the North Slope, the western part of the state,  
8 and the Aleutian Chain. The functions of the department within each region shall  
9 be performed, to the maximum extent feasible, through a regional office. Each  
10 regional office shall be directed by a regional transportation and public facilities  
11 director appointed by the commissioner.
