A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to allowable absences from the state for purposes of eligibility**
2 **for permanent fund dividends; and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1. AS 43.23.095(8) is amended to read:**

5 **(8) "state resident" means an individual who is physically present in the**
6 **state with the intent to remain permanently in the state under the requirements of**
7 **AS 01.10.055 or, if the individual is not physically present in the state, intends to**
8 **return to the state and remain permanently in the state under the requirements of**
9 **AS 01.10.055, and is absent only for any of the following reasons:**

10 **(A) vocational, professional, or other specific education for**
11 **which a comparable program was not reasonably available in the state;**

12 **(B) secondary or postsecondary education;**

13 **(C) military service;**

14 **(D) medical treatment;**

- 1 (E) service in Congress;
2 (F) other reasons which the commissioner may establish by
3 regulation; [OR]
4 (G) service in the Peace Corps;
5 (H) service in the United States Merchant Marine: or
6 (I) service in the commissioned corps of the United States
7 Public Health Service:

8 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1995.
