**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the retirement rights of temporary hourly employees hired  
2 by the legislature."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* Section 1. AS 24.10.060(e) is amended to read:

5 (e) The permanent interim committees of the legislature, the rules committees,  
6 the president of the senate, or the speaker of the house of representatives, as  
7 appropriate, may authorize the employment of hourly employees. Hourly employees  
8 are subject to the salary schedule set out in AS 39.27.011. Temporary hourly  
9 employees are not covered by AS 14.25 or AS 39.35 and [GENERAL STATE  
10 LAWS REGARDING RETIREMENT BUT] are not entitled to receive leave benefits.  
11 An employee may not be hired as a temporary hourly employee for longer than  
12 400 hours in a calendar year.
