**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to issuance of commemorative gold rush motor vehicle license  
2 plates; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.161(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The department, upon registering a vehicle, shall issue the owner one fully  
6 reflectorized registration plate for a [TRAILER OR A MOTORCYCLE AND TWO  
7 FULLY REFLECTORIZED REGISTRATION PLATES FOR EVERY OTHER]  
8 vehicle. Except as specifically provided in AS 28.10.181, the plate [OR PLATES]  
9 must remain with the vehicle as long as the vehicle is subject to registration under this  
10 chapter.

11 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (s) Special request gold rush commemorative plates. The department shall  
13 issue registration plates commemorating the gold rush period in the state upon  
14 application by the owner of a passenger vehicle, noncommercial van or pick-up truck,

- 1 or motor home. The commissioner shall determine the design and color of gold rush
- 2 commemorative plates.
- 3 • Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act takes effect January 1, 1996.
