A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the introduction of bills and resolutions by legislators."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * Section 1. AS 24.08.060(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A [MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE OR A] committee **chair**
5 [CHAIRMAN], with the concurrence of a majority of the active members of the
6 committee and on behalf of the committee, may introduce a bill or resolution. **During**
7 **the two-year period of a legislature a member may introduce as prime sponsor**
8 **no more than 12 measures including both bills and resolutions. A measure the**
9 **member cosponsors is not counted towards this total if another member is the**
10 **prime sponsor.** Bills and resolutions shall be prepared and introduced in the manner
11 and form prescribed in the uniform rules and the legislative style manual.
