A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature
2 relating to deadlines for session work; and providing for an effective date.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. The Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature are amended by adding
5 a new rule to read:

6 RULE 56. SESSION SCHEDULE. (a) The following schedule applies to
7 consideration of a bill during a first regular or second regular session:

8 (1) the house of origin may not calendar a bill for second reading after
9 the 90th legislative day;

10 (2) a bill may not be transmitted by the house of origin to the second
11 house after the 95th legislative day;

12 (3) the second house may not calendar a bill for first or second reading
13 after the 114th legislative day;

14 (4) a bill may not be transmitted by the second house to the house of
15 origin after the 117th legislative day;

16 (5) a report of a Conference Committee, Conference Committee with

1 limited powers of free conference, or Free Conference Committee may not be
2 submitted after the 118th legislative day.

3 (b) Notwithstanding Uniform Rule 49(5), this rule does not apply to joint
4 resolutions or other types of resolutions. This rule may be suspended by a concurrent
5 resolution approved by majority vote in each house.

6 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution takes effect on the convening of the
7 Second Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.
