A RESOLUTION

1 **Proposing an amendment to the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature**
2 **relating to deadlines for session work; and providing for an effective date.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** The Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature are amended by adding
5 a new rule to read:

6 **RULE 56. SESSION SCHEDULE.** (a) The following schedule applies during
7 a first and second session to consideration of a bill:

8 (1) the house of origin may not calendar a bill for second reading after
9 the 105th legislative day of a first session or after the 90th legislative day of a second
10 session;

11 (2) a bill may not be transmitted by the house of origin to the second
12 house after the 110th legislative day of a first session or the 95th legislative day of a
13 second session;

14 (3) the second house may not calendar a bill for first or second reading
15 after the 113th legislative day;

16 (4) a bill may not be transmitted by the second house to the house of

1 origin after the 115th legislative day;

2 (5) a report of a Conference Committee, Conference Committee with
3 limited powers of free conference, or Free Conference Committee may not be
4 submitted after the 117th legislative day.

5 (b) An appropriation bill or a committee substitute for an appropriation bill
6 may not be voted on by a house until at least 24 hours after it is duplicated and
7 delivered to the chief clerk or secretary of the house for distribution to each member.
8 The chief clerk or secretary shall certify the time of delivery of the report for recording
9 in the journal.

10 (c) This rule may be suspended by a concurrent resolution approved by
11 majority vote in each house. Notwithstanding Uniform Rule 49, this rule does not
12 apply to joint or other resolutions.

13 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution takes effect on the convening of the
14 Second Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.
