A RESOLUTION

1 **Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to**
2 **the individual right to keep and bear arms.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** Article I, sec. 19, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:

5 **SECTION 19. RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS.** A well-regulated
6 militia being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep
7 and bear arms shall not be infringed. **The individual right to keep and bear arms**
8 **shall not be denied or infringed by the State or a political subdivision of the State.**

9 *** Sec. 2.** The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of
10 the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the
11 State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
