A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a House Special Committee on International Trade and Tourism.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

3 WHEREAS international trade and tourism are of increasing importance to the
4 economy of the state; and

5 WHEREAS the legislature should be well-informed about developments in
6 international trade and tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and

7 WHEREAS the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for visitors
8 to experience the life and scenic grandeur of the state; and

9 WHEREAS the state should promote and facilitate the export of the products and
10 services of the state;

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
12 on International Trade and Tourism is established to study issues relating to international trade
13 and tourism; and be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
15 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee, and shall appoint
16 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on International Trade

1 and Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Eighteenth Alaska State
2 Legislature, and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Nineteenth Alaska
3 State Legislature.
