A RESOLUTION

1 Relating to the state's settlements with the dairy farmers at Point MacKenzie.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

3 WHEREAS the state administration has made financial settlements with some, but not
4 all, of the Point MacKenzie dairy farmers; and

5 WHEREAS, based on the April 1992 investigative report made by the Office of the
6 Ombudsman on the Point MacKenzie settlements, it appears that the settlements may have
7 been reached by using different process guidelines and performance standards; and

8 WHEREAS it would be helpful to the House of Representatives if the Department of
9 Law reviewed the report's findings and recommendations, including the proposed mitigating
10 solutions, regarding the equity and consistency of the process guidelines and performance
11 standards used to reach the settlements;

12 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the
13 Governor to direct the Department of Law to review the April 1992 report by the Office of
14 the Ombudsman on the Point MacKenzie settlements, to consider the recommendations,
15 including the mitigating solutions, made by the Office of the Ombudsman regarding the equity
16 and consistency of the process guidelines and performance standards used to reach the
17 settlements, and to make recommendations to the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee

1 on the implementation of the recommendations in the report.
