A RESOLUTION

1 Relating to adjournment of the First Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State
2 Legislature, and certifying to Governor Walter J. Hickel the disagreement between
3 the two houses respecting the time of the legislature's adjournment.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

5 WHEREAS, under art. II, sec. 10 of the state constitution, if the two houses of the
6 legislature cannot agree on the time for adjournment, either house may certify the
7 disagreement to the governor; and

8 WHEREAS, upon receipt of a certification of disagreement from one house, the
9 governor may adjourn the legislature; and

10 WHEREAS the House of Representatives has completed its business and stands ready
11 to adjourn, but cannot reach agreement with the Senate on the time for adjournment; and

12 WHEREAS the House members of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature desire to
13 conclude the regular session in conformity with the constitution and laws of the state and the
14 Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature and without causing offense to our colleagues
15 in the other body;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives, having concluded its business

1 and being now ready to adjourn from the First Session of the Alaska State Legislature,
2 certifies to Governor Walter J. Hickel under art. II, sec. 10 its disagreement with the Senate
3 over the time of adjournment of the First Regular Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State
4 Legislature; and be it

5 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the
6 governor to exercise the authority given under art. II, sec. 10 of the state constitution and to
7 immediately adjourn the First Regular Session of the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature.
