A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act authorizing moose farming."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 16.40.010 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 16.40.010. DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS BUFFALO, MOOSE, OR
5 [AND] MUSK OXEN. Whenever it is determined by the department that a surplus
6 [EXISTS IN THE HERDS] of buffalo, moose, or [AND] musk oxen exists [UNDER
7 ITS CONTROL], the department may, under regulations adopted by it, grant the
8 surplus or portions of it to persons, groups, associations, partnerships, or corporations
9 for the purpose of raising and breeding the animals as domestic stock for commercial
10 purposes, or for scientific and educational purposes. A person, group, association,
11 partnership, or corporation may receive animals only after proving to the satisfaction
12 of the department
13 (1) intent to raise and breed the animals; and
14 (2) possession of facilities for maintaining the animals under positive

3 Sec. 16.40.020. SALE OF MEAT. The sale of buffalo, moose, or musk oxen
4 meat resulting from the slaughter of animals obtained under AS 16.40.010, or their
5 offspring is authorized.
