A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act making appropriations to the school construction grant fund for school
2 projects; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the school
5 construction grant fund (AS 14.11.005) for payment by the Department of Education as
6 matching grants subject to AS 14.11.017(a) and other applicable law for school projects in the
7 senate districts specified and are further allocated in the amounts listed for the purposes
8 expressed:

31	* Sec. 2. The appropriations made by this Act are contingent upon the enactment into law	

1 of a bill passed by the Eighteenth Alaska State Legislature that establishes a matching grant
2 program for school construction and maintenance.

3 * Sec. 3. In sec. 1 of this Act, "qualified projects" means those projects within a senate
4 district or group of senate districts for which funds are appropriated that

5 (1) have been approved by the state Board of Education under AS 14.11.005 -
6 14.11.017; and

7 (2) have the highest priority ranking under AS 14.11.015 among otherwise
8 unfunded projects within the district or districts that can be completed with the amount of
9 funds available for grants in the district or districts.

10 * Sec. 4. The appropriations made by this Act are for capital projects and lapse under
11 AS 37.25.020.

12 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1993.
