A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act making appropriations for school construction projects and making an
2 appropriation of \$1,066,280 from the general fund to the Department of Education
3 for payment as grants for additional district support for the fiscal year ending
4 June 30, 1994; and providing for an effective date."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 * Section 1. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the school
7 construction grant fund (AS 14.11.005) for payment by the Department of Education as grants
8 subject to AS 14.11.017(a) and other applicable law for school projects in the senate districts
9 specified and are further allocated in the amounts listed for the purposes expressed:
