FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to civil liability for workplace safety inspections; and providing
2 and effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. AS 21.89 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 21.89.017. IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR WORKPLACE
6 SAFETY INSPECTIONS. An insurer, an insurance service agent to a self-insured
7 employer, or a trade association is not liable for civil damages as a result of an act or
8 omission in performing or failing to perform a workplace safety inspection or a safety
9 advisory service unless the insurer's, agent's, or association's act or failure to act
10 constitutes intentional misconduct.

11 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
