A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to civil liability for workplace safety inspections; and providing  
2 for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 23.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5           Sec. 23.30.263. IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR WORKPLACE  
6 SAFETY INSPECTIONS. An employer's safety inspector is not liable for civil  
7 damages for an injury to an employee of that employer resulting from an act or  
8 omission in performing or failing to perform a loss control service, a workplace safety  
9 inspection, or a safety advisory service provided in connection with an employer's  
10 workers' compensation insurance coverage, unless the act or failure to act constitutes  
11 intentional misconduct. In this section, "safety inspector" means a carrier and an  
12 employee or agent of the carrier, a trade association of which the employer is a  
13 member, or a person providing adjusting or inspection services to an employer who  
14 is a member of an association established under AS 21.76.010 or an employer who is

1 self-insured under AS 23.30.090.

2 • Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
