A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the charging, prosecuting, and sentencing of certain minors  
2 concerning offenses of murder in the first degree, attempted murder in the first  
3 degree, murder in the second degree, and certain other offenses; and providing  
4 for an effective date."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

6 \* Section 1. AS 47.10.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 (e) Except as provided in this subsection, when a minor who is 16 years of age  
8 or older is arraigned on a charge of murder in the first degree, attempted murder in the  
9 first degree, or murder in the second degree, AS 47.10.020 - 47.10.090 do not apply  
10 to the offense and any additional offenses joinable under the applicable rules of court  
11 governing criminal procedure. Instead, such a minor shall be charged, prosecuted, and  
12 sentenced in the superior court in the same manner as an adult.

13 \* Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. The changes made by this Act apply only to offenses  
14 committed on or after July 1, 1993. An offense committed before July 1, 1993 shall be

- 1 adjudicated or prosecuted under the provisions of law existing at the time that the offense was
- 2 committed.
- 3 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1993.
