A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to disposals of state land within five miles of the right-of-way
2 of the Dalton Highway to a licensed public utility or a licensed common carrier;
3 relating to disposals of state land for nonresidential development in nodes of
4 development along the Dalton Highway; and allowing state leases and materials
5 sales for reconstruction and maintenance of state highways and construction or
6 maintenance of airports."

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

8 * Section 1. AS 19.40.200(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) The prohibition on disposal of state land under (a) of this section does not
10 apply to a disposal

11 (1) to a licensed public utility or a licensed common carrier under

12 AS 38.05.810(e);

13 (2) for nonresidential development within the Yukon River

1 Crossing, Coldfoot, Happy Valley, Franklin Bluffs, and Deadhorse development
2 nodes; or

3 (3) necessary for

4 (A) [(1)] an oil and gas lease under AS 38.05.180;

5 (B) [(2)] exploration, development, production, or transportation
6 of oil and gas north of 68 degrees north latitude; or

7 (C) [(3)] a state lease or materials sale for

8 (i) exploration, development, production, or transportation
9 of oil and gas; [OR]

10 (ii) reconstruction or maintenance of state highways; or

11 (iii) construction or maintenance of airports [THE
12 HIGHWAY NORTH OF 68 DEGREES NORTH LATITUDE].
