A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to reimbursable service agreements and other agreements
2 between state agencies for the purchase of services."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 37.07.080(e) is amended to read:

5 (e) Transfers or changes between objects of expenditures or between
6 allocations may be made by the head of an [A STATE] agency upon approval of the
7 office. Transfers may not be made between appropriations except as provided in an
8 act making the transfers between appropriations. An agency may not, through the
9 use of a reimbursable service agreement or other agreement with another agency,
10 transfer money between appropriations. However, a reimbursable service
11 agreement or other agreement may be used to purchase a service if the agency
12 that

13 (1) purchases the service has, by law, the authority to obtain or
14 provide the service and has funds appropriated to it that may be used for that

1 purpose; and

2 (2) provides the service has, by law, the authority to do so and bills

3 the purchasing agency based on

4 (A) the actual cost of providing the service; or

5 (B) a cost allocation method approved by the office.
